









Language Calendar

Go on a number hunt in your house; look for numbers 1-5.
Sort jellybeans by color. 	Go jump in puddles in the rain; go to www.moogcenter.org for language ideas.	Label 5 things outside; talk about the first sound you hear at the beginning of each word.	 Collect sticks outside; talk about which ones are thin vs. thick.	List as many different breakfast foods as you can.
Talk about how to stay safe during a thunderstorm. 	Go on a family egg hunt; hide plastic eggs around your house or yard and take turns finding them.	Go to the library; check out a book about Spring. 	Talk about the stores you pass while riding in the car.	Talk about when you should say, "sorry" to someone.
Get dressed for school; label your body parts.	Sing "Old MacDonald Had a Farm" with a friend; take turns picking the animal.	Dye or paint eggs; talk about each step.	Trace around shadows with chalk; move things around to make new shadows.	Hop like a bunny to different rooms in your house. 
Visit Suson Park and Animal Farm; talk about the animals you see.	Make a birdfeeder with half an orange, string, peanut butter and birdseed; talk about the birds that come to eat.	Talk about something you did with a friend at recess. 	Practice cutting shapes out of paper.	Help put away laundry; count all the shirts with buttons.
